## Question for written answer E-000517/2024 to the Commission

Subject: Unfair competition due to dumping in the Catalan and Valencian citrus fruit sector

Citrus production in Catalonia follows EU phytosanitary norms that are not always followed by producers in non-EU countries. The EU's Rapid Alert System for Food and Feed has revealed that, since the beginning of 2024, batches of citrus fruits from Türkiye<sup>1</sup> and from Egypt have been rejected due to the excessive presence of pesticides banned in the EU<sup>2</sup>.

Moreover, working conditions in these countries are poor, with salaries of between EUR 5 and EUR 10 per day<sup>3</sup>. Catalonia's citrus farmers' pay will fall by between 60 % and 80 % this season compared to last season: oranges account for a third of citrus production, and clementine-type tangerines the other two thirds. Of these, a harvest of about 88 500 tonnes is expected, a significant drop since 2021, when 130 000 tonnes were harvested. Finally, Catalonia's citrus farmers are mostly smallholders or SMEs<sup>4</sup>. Valencian farmers are experiencing similar problems<sup>5</sup>.

- 1. Will the Commission introduce the antidumping procedure set in place by Regulation (EU) 2016/1036<sup>6</sup> and Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) 2019/1793<sup>7</sup> to help Catalan citrus farmers?
- 2. How will the Commission ensure that Catalan and European citrus producers will not incur excessive financial losses due to the abovementioned facts?
