Would the Commission please set out what conditions must apply in order for it to intervene in a motorway project, so as to ensure that construction complies with the EU's EIA Directive, Habitats Directive, Water Framework Directive and Natura 2000, a case in point being the motorway on route 54 between Næstved and Rønnede in Denmark?
