Question for written answer E-000737/2024 to the Commission Rule 138 César Luena (S&D)

Subject: Fulfilment of 30X30 protection pledges by Member States

As part of the EU Biodiversity Strategy 2030, Member States pledge to protect 30 % of the EU's land and 30 % of its marine areas by 2030, of which 10 % must be strictly protected.

In this regard, it was expected that Member States would submit their individual pledges and thus their contribution to the 30 % protection objective, as outlined in the strategy, before the end of 2023.

As the European Commission mentioned in its answer to question E-003201/2023, up until the date of the answer (15/12/2023), only five of the twenty seven Member States had submitted their pledges regarding protected areas.

- 1. Could the European Commission clarify which other Member States have submitted their pledges since then?
- 2. What is the Commission planning to do in the event that Member States do not submit their pledges?
- 3. Based on the pledges that have already been submitted, does the Commission consider that the EU is on the right track to reach its protection objectives by 2030?
