Subject: Follow-up question: Transposition of the Work-Life Balance Directive

The Work-Life Balance Directive was adopted in 2019. Its aim is to achieve a better balance between family and work obligations.

Member States were required to transpose the directive into national law by 2 August 2022 at the latest. In its answer dated 14 October 2022 (P-002835/2022(ASW)¹) the Commission stated that only eight Member States had transposed the directive into national law.

- 1. Can the Commission say which Member States had transposed the directive by 18 March 2024?
- 2. Will Member States that have failed to meet the deadline be penalised?
