Subject: First-aid training for citizens

The provision of first aid plays an exceptionally important role in the rapid response to emergencies and accidents and can literally save lives. However, there is little instruction or awareness-raising. The absence of a uniform training plan becomes even more apparent if we compare the different approaches taken by Member States.

On the basis of the above and my previous question E-008747-15¹:

1. Does the Commission have detailed data on first-aid training for citizens, and if so, what is the situation in Greece?
2. How does it plan to raise awareness among citizens and give them incentives to take appropriate training, and what financial tools can be made available to promote similar education in school curricula?
3. How does the Commission intend to standardise first-aid training methods in Member States with the aim of ensuring the highest possible quality?
