Question for written answer E-001053/2024 to the Commission Rule 138 Alexandr Vondra (ECR)

Subject: Reduction in EU GDP by about 7 % by the end of the century

On page 7 of its communication entitled 'Managing climate risks – protecting people and prosperity' (COM(2024)0091), the Commission states that the 'conservative estimate is that worsening climate impacts could reduce EU GDP by about 7 % by the end of the century', without citing any relevant source. For example, the European Climate Risk Assessment (EUCRA) report is completely silent on such a scenario.

In this context:

- 1. Where does this figure of 7 % come from?
- 2. If there are any other estimates, how has the conservative one been calculated?
- 3. What measures will the Commission take in the future to ensure that its policies are data-driven and properly assessed for their impact?
