## Question for written answer E-001073/2024 to the Commission Rule 138 Dietmar Köster (S&D)

## Subject: Frontex

At 12:24 UTC on 6 March 2024, Sea-Watch 5 rescued a boat in distress at 33° 38' N 011° 35' E. Of the 56 persons rescued, 4 were in a very critical medical condition. One of them later passed away aboard Sea-Watch 5.

Before launching the rescue operation, the crew aboard Sea-Watch 5 sighted an aircraft circling above the boat that was in distress. According to open-source platforms, the Frontex aircraft with the call sign SPAROW4 was flying on that day.

I would therefore like to know:

- 1. At what time and in which position did SPAROW4 or any other Frontex asset first spot the boat that was rescued by Sea-Watch 5 at 12:24 UTC on 6 March 2024 at 33° 38' N 011° 35' E?
- 2. What was Frontex's risk assessment of the boat with regard to distress criteria?
- 3. Which kind of documentation did Frontex take of the boat and of the subsequent rescue operation, and with which authorities was which information shared?

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
