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Automated traffic management systems for trains Subject:

Automated traffic management systems for trains are currently only used on a small section of Europe's railway network. Signalling, remote control systems, ETCS and GSMR contribute to the safer functioning of the railway network. Despite this, only 14 % of European rail has an operational automatic train stop system.

In view of this:

- 1. Is the Commission looking into the possibility of making automatic train stop systems compulsory in EU Member States and, if so, as of when will this apply?
- 2. Is it considering other mandatory measures for the safer use of European trains?

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
