Subject: Recognition of the right to a healthy environment

Parliament has repeatedly called for the promotion of the right to a healthy environment. More specifically, Parliament has called for the EU to promote global recognition of the right to a safe, clean, healthy and sustainable environment at a global level<sup>1</sup>.

Furthermore, it has called for the Union to take action to introduce the right to a safe and healthy environment in the Charter of Fundamental Rights of the European Union and to fully comply with Article 37 thereof. Parliament has also stressed the importance of close cooperation with states and all relevant institutional actors involved in ensuring the proper implementation of human rights and environmental provisions<sup>2</sup>, and that the EU should lead the initiative to recognise a similar right internationally<sup>3</sup>.

- 1. Could the Commission explain in detail what steps it has taken, and intends to take, to ensure the recognition of the right to a safe, clean, healthy and sustainable environment at the global level?
- 2. Does the Commission agree that it is not enough to only take steps at the global level, but that they are also needed at the European level?
- 3. Does the Commission agree with Parliament that the right to a safe and healthy environment should be included in the Charter? If so, what measures does the Commission intend to take, and what is the timeline? If not, why not?
