Subject: Compatibility with EU law of 1946 Czech law on impunity

Article 49 of the Treaty on European Union (TEU) states that any European State which respects the principles set out in Article 6 TEU may become a member of the European Union.

Does the Commission consider that provisions such as those contained in the 1946 law on impunity, which legalise acts of vengeance for the actions of the occupying forces and their supporters - at worst assaults on life and limb - are compatible with European Union law (Articles 6 and 49 TEU)?
