In mid-January 2003 the UN Secretary-General's personal envoy for Western Sahara undertook a tour of countries in the region in order to submit a proposal for resolving the conflict to the parties.

What is the European Council's position on the proposals by the Secretary-General's personal envoy for Western Sahara? Does the Council believe that the proposal for resolving the conflict may disregard the inalienable right of the Saharawis to self-determination?
