Subject: Wall on Palestinian territory

The International Court of Justice in The Hague recently began a hearing on the legality of the construction by Israel of the wall in the occupied West Bank of Palestine, which violates the basic rights of freedom of movement and access of Palestinians to their property.

What is the Commission's position on this specific hearing at the International Court of Justice in The Hague?

Does it intend to intervene in the hearing and if so, how? What actions does it intend to take to promote political solution to this problem based on international law wither through the International Court of Justice or by means of a political procedure?
