I.2.1 Main items of the Conference of Committee Chairs

Ratification of the EU-UK trade and cooperation agreement and the process in the Parliament: the Chairwoman stressed the need to ensure that Parliament's prerogatives are safeguarded so that it can exercise its democratic scrutiny, and that the implementation of the agreement should be monitored by the committees responsible for individual policy areas.

ECON Hearing on "How to address competition and taxation challenges in the digital economy?" (PS, AM, AK, BM)		<p>On 7 December 2020, the CCC recommended modalities of cooperation for this hearing. The CCC noted that the scope of the hearing clearly falls within ECON remit in line with Annex VI of the Rules of Procedure and that, therefore, its request fulfils the criteria to be forwarded to the Parliament's Bureau for authorization.</p> <p>However, given the importance of this hearing for Parliament as a whole, the CCC recommended that ECON should, in its allocation of speaking</p>

		<p>time, grant one question each to ECON Members, who are also Members or Substitutes in the IMCO, ITRE and JURI Committees.</p> <p>The CCC also noted that every committee has the right to request the organization of a public hearing with the CEOs of the GAFA companies in order to discuss issues falling under its own competences.</p> <p>The ECON hearing was on the Bureau agenda on 18 January 2021.</p>
CULT INI “Towards European Digital Public Sphere” (PS/BM)		<p>On 29 October 2020, the CULT Committee requested authorisation to draw up a non-legislative own-initiative report on “Towards European Digital Public Sphere”. This concept is described as a digital ecosystem that would observe, in its technical design, values such as transparency and openness and that would create a digital space, thereby strengthening public debate and safeguarding and promoting media pluralism and cultural diversity that form part of Europe’s identity. The report intends to look into, among others, the organisation and financing of that sphere as well as the infrastructure-related aspects of the sphere’s expansion.</p> <p>On 12 November 2020, IMCO requested clarification of the scope and the aim of the requested report, reserving a decision as to the scope of involvement that IMCO would request (potentially an association under Rule 57) on the CULT report, until that clarification is provided.</p> <p>Following exchanges on the requested report between the secretariats, CULT offered IMCO association under Rule 57 RoP with shared competences. Detailed modalities of the association are still under discussion.</p>

<p>IMCO INI “Tackling non-tariff barriers in the Single Market” (SvS/BM/CM)</p>	<p>On 27 October 2020, the IMCO Coordinators confirmed their decision of 25 September 2019 to request authorisation to draw up the own-initiative report under Rule 54 of the Rules of Procedure on “Tackling non-tariff barriers in the Single Market”, also expanding its scope to barriers that were imposed by Member States as a response to the COVID crisis. The letter with the authorisation request was sent to CCC on 11 November.</p> <p>On 20 November, ECON and FISC sent a letter requesting that ECON be associated to the report under Rule 57 with exclusive competence on VAT and other tax-related matters that could be considered non-tariff barriers. According to the letter, VAT is identified in the 2016 IMCO report on “Non-tariff barriers in the Single Market” and in Commission communication of 10 March 2020 on “Identifying and addressing barriers to the Single Market” as being one important non-tariffs barrier in the single market.</p> <p>On 2 December, the IMCO Coordinators agreed to accept ECON/FISC association under Rule 57, clearly identifying that the association would cover only the matters covering VAT under ECON and FISC exclusive competences. On 9 December, the IMCO Chair informed the CCC of this position, refusing to accept an extension of the scope of a report only to serve the purpose of covering the competences of another committee.</p> <p>Despite an exchange between the IMCO Chair and the ECON Chair, who provisionally agreed that ECON/FISC participation in Non-tariff barriers INI could be limited to VAT matters, while IMCO clarified that it will not go into tax matters in its report, this provisional agreement has never been confirmed by ECON/FISC.</p> <p>Given this situation, IMCO asked the CCC for a speedy recommendation in order for the IMCO report to be authorised by the CoP.</p> <p>Following this, another attempt was made by the Chairs in which IMCO Chair found agreement with</p>
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		FISC Chair, yet it was not endorsed by ECON. Possible agreement is still under discussion between the Committees.
JURI INL "Digitalisation and Administrative Law" (TKV/SD)		On 18 December 2020, JURI requested authorisation to draw up a legislative own-initiative report on "Digitalisation and Administrative Law". IMCO asked for an involvement under Rule 57 of the RoP for matters falling within its remit, in particular regarding the use of digital tools, artificial intelligence (AI) and data.
IMCO hearing on "Regulation of online platforms and digital service providers in the digital single market: ensuring effective protection of European consumers in the digital economy" (AM/AK/PS/BM)		During the CCC written procedure of 18/19 January, ECON asked for clarification that the planned hearing will not touch upon matters falling with the competences of the ECON committee. ECON reserved its position on the request for authorisation of the hearing until the above-mentioned clarification has been received.

They agreed to support the Chairwoman in defending IMCO's interests towards other committees and in the CCC. They also stressed that any conflicts with other committees should be resolved as soon as possible so that IMCO can concentrate on the legislative work.
