#### Part I: items for decision with debate

##### **I.1 Adoption of the draft agenda**

The agenda was adopted, as shown in these decisions.

##### **I.2 Announcements**

The Chair welcomed Elena MAINARDI as new Head of Unit in the IMCO Secretariat and informed IMCO Coordinators that the Greens/EFA appointed Kim VAN SPARRENTAK as new IMCO Coordinator replacing Marcel KOLAJA.

##### **I.2.1 Main items of the Conference of Committee Chairs**

The Chair informed that at its meeting of 15 February, MEP Bernd Lange, INTA Chair, was elected as new CCC Chair by acclamation.

The new CCC Chair is committed to explore way forwards to improve the modalities of cooperation between committees in view to reduce their conflict of competence and facilitate a rapid solution.

IMCO Coordinators were also informed of the President of the Parliament's decision on the possibility for the committees to exercise their voting rights under the remote participation regime until 12 June 2022.



## I.2.2 Modalities of cooperation with other Committees: State of Play

<p><b>Transparency and targeting of political advertising</b> 2021/0381(COD)</p> <p>(BM/JRV)</p>	<p>The proposal was published by the Commission on 25 December. On 13 December it was announced in Plenary and referred to IMCO as Lead Committee, with JURI, LIBE and AFCO for Opinion. CULT was added only later for opinion following their request.</p> <p>On 11 January CULT sent a letter to the CCC requesting "at least" Rule 57 (mentioning that it could also be Rule 58). On 14 January CULT sent a second letter, expanding the arguments described in the first, and requesting (disproportionately) the application of Rule 58 based on their competences on the AVMSD, as they claim some political advertisement can be made on TV or written press and not only on platforms.</p> <p>On 13 January LIBE sent a letter requesting association under Rule 57, with exclusive competence on matters under their remit, especially Articles 12 &amp; 13, as they involve the processing of personal data.</p> <p>Despite numerous efforts by IMCO Chair, no agreement with LIBE or CULT was found yet. On 25th of February, the Chair thus addressed a letter to the CCC to respond to their requests, proposing compromises: to LIBE Rule 57, with exclusive and shared elements, in respect of data protection and Rule 56+ in respect of their other claims; and to CULT Rule 56+ in respect of the media policy angle. The Chair also stressed IMCO's openness to enhanced participation of both LIBE and CULT during the whole legislative process.</p> <p>A CCC recommendation is currently in preparation.</p>
<p><b>ITRE INI - "Implementation of the Updated New Industrial Strategy for Europe: aligning spending to policy"</b></p> <p>(GdS)</p>	<p>On 5 July 2021 ITRE's Chair requested authorization to draw up an INI on "Implementation of the Updated New Industrial Strategy for Europe: aligning spending to policy".</p> <p>This INI would be a follow-up of the ITRE INI on "A new industrial strategy for Europe", adopted in 2020, for which IMCO provided a simple Opinion (Bielan - 2020/2076 INI), and would take into account the new information provided by the Commission in the Communication titled "Updating the 2020 New Industrial Strategy: Building a stronger Single Market for Europe's recovery" (COM(2021)0350).</p> <p>Considering that some parts of this Communication are related to the internal market, IMCO's Chair on 14 July 2021 requested to ITRE to clarify that the INI didn't intend to cover issues that are under IMCO's competence.</p> <p>ITRE's Chair replied on 28 October 2021, highlighting that the purpose of the INI would be to follow-up on the earlier INI on "A New Industrial Strategy for Europe", taking also into account the Commission Communication mentioned above, by addressing implementation issues with a forward-looking focus particularly on aligning spending to the existing policy.</p> <p>Since the answer by ITRE didn't clarify the matter, IMCO's Chair replied on 9 November 2021 informing ITRE's Chair that, without the aforementioned clarification, IMCO would ask for association under rule 57 for the parts related to Chapter 2, 3 and 4 of the Commission Communication.</p> <p>INTA and TRAN Committee also requested association under Rule 57.</p> <p>On 19 November 2021 ITRE's Chair sent a letter to the CCC's Chair asking for a Recommendation to solve the issue.</p> <p>On 7 January 2022 the CCC Chair recommended to the CoP that ITRE Committee remains responsible and that the IMCO, TRAN and INTA Committees contribute</p>

	<p>with opinions under Rule 56+, with the following additional elements of cooperation:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- IMCO, TRAN and INTA Rapporteurs shall be invited to attend all exchanges of views, workshops and hearings scheduled in the ITRE committee;</li> <li>- IMCO, TRAN and INTA Rapporteurs shall be invited to attend the ITRE Committee's shadows meetings;</li> <li>- Bilateral meetings shall take place between the IMCO, TRAN, INTA and ITRE Rapporteurs regarding the opinion-giving committees' specific interests and concerns.</li> </ul> <p>On 20 January 2022 the CoP endorsed the CCC Recommendation.</p>
<p><b>AFET/INTA – INI Implementation report on the EU-UK Trade and Cooperation Agreement</b>  (CM/MaC)</p>	<p>By letter D 307675 of 16 November the AFET and INTA Chairs requested the authorisation of an implementation report on the EU-UK Trade and Cooperation Agreement (TCA), indicating that the procedure for that report should be equal to the one on the implementation report on the Withdrawal Agreement, 2020/2202(INI). Nevertheless, the organization and distribution of work by committees, and particularly the role of the committees with the relevant sectoral expertise in the scrutiny of both the Withdrawal Agreement and the TCA is still subject to discussion. By letter of 7 December D(2021)27076 IMCO requested the withholding of the authorisation of the TCA implementation report until an agreement within the CCC on the competencies in the scrutiny is found.</p> <p>At the CCC meeting of December the AFET/INTA request was not endorsed. CCC Chair Tajani called for finding a compromise for the next CCC meeting, to make sure that the expertise of relevant committees is properly taken into account.</p> <p>The discussion in CCC on the appropriate modus operandi on UK implementation reports is still pending. The item is currently not scheduled to be discussed at the March CCC.</p>
<p><b>CULT INI E-sport and videogames</b>  (GdS/MiC)</p>	<p>On 8 December 2021, CULT Committee's Chair requested the authorisation to draw up an own initiative report on "E-sport and videogames".</p> <p>In its letter, the CULT Committee considers that the topic would be a follow-up of the Parliament's Resolution of 23 November 2021 on "EU sports policy: assessment and possible ways forward" (2021/2058(INI)).</p> <p>Considering that in the Resolution mentioned above there is no reference to video games and that the title and the content of the requested INI seem to broaden the scope to issues that may fall within IMCO remit, such as consumer protection in the gaming sector, including online video games, online gambling, and compliance of online platforms, on 13 December 2021 IMCO's Chair requested a clarification of the precise scope of the INI.</p> <p>On 14 January 2022 CULT Committee's Chair replied to the request of clarification by stating that CULT's approach is to tackle the topic under the sports' angle, with an additional focus on youth engagement, creativity and educational aspects and to continue the discussion initiated by the EP resolution on 'EU sports policy', which called for the EU institutions to launch a debate on the future and opportunities of "E-sport". CULT's Chair underlined that INI report will not be focused on topics under IMCO's exclusive competences. IMCO is satisfied with the agreement reached.</p>
<p><b>Common rules for the internal markets in renewable and natural gases and in hydrogen</b> COM(2021)0803 –</p>	<p>On 25 January, Coordinators decided to request the application of Rule 57 RoP with exclusive and shared competences. The secretariat has identified a list of Articles and corresponding Recitals which should fall under IMCO remit. As the proposal hasn't been announced in plenary yet, discussions between IMCO and ITRE Chairs are in preparation.</p>

<p><b>Making available on the Union market as well as export from the Union of certain commodities and products associated with deforestation and forest degradation and repealing Regulation (EU) No 995/2010</b> COM(2021)0706 – 2021/0366(COD) – IMCO/9/xxxxx"</p> <p>(DB/CM/GdS)</p>	<p>Referral to ENVI in plenary on 17 January.</p> <p>Following a decision on 25 January to request an enhanced cooperation under Rule 57 by IMCO Coordinators, a letter was sent to the CCC on 14 February underlining the provisions under IMCO remit. In parallel discussions between IMCO and ENVI Chairs took place to find a possible common ground but despite IMCO Chair's efforts to strive for a compromise an agreement was not possible.</p> <p>At its meeting of 15 February, the CCC made public an agreement between INTA and ENVI on the modalities of cooperation agreed between the two Committees, offering INTA an association with exclusive and shared competences. IMCO was not invited to participate in such agreement despite it touched parts under IMCO remit.</p> <p>A new IMCO Chair's letter to the CCC replied on 28th February to the ENVI-INTA agreement to propose a possible way forward of modalities of cooperation that takes into account the different Committees' competences without jeopardising the ENVI-INTA agreement.</p> <p>On this basis, an ENVI/IMCO agreement was found on 8 March, according to which IMCO will be associated (Rule 57 RoP) with shared competences on a number of provisions of the proposal regarding due diligence obligations of operators, market surveillance and customs. The agreement should be endorsed at the CoP meeting in April.</p>
<p><b>AccessibleEU Centre in support of accessibility policies in the EU internal market</b> (2022/2013(INI))</p> <p>(KB/sj/jrv)</p>	<p>The CCC endorsed this IMCO INI request via written procedure on 18 January 2022.</p> <p>Thereafter, the EMPL Coordinators decided to request Rule 57, but were informed by the CCC secretariat that their request was late and could only be considered, if IMCO agreed to it.</p> <p>The IMCO Coordinators agreed on 25 January, in the spirit of good cooperation between the committees, to invite EMPL to contribute with an opinion under Rule 56+.</p> <p>IMCO secretariat was informed by the EMPL secretariat however on 3 February that EMPL has withdrawn its request and will not draw up an opinion on this file.</p>

In the current difficult situation, it is also necessary to look forward, identifying further growth potential and reaching out to the main stakeholders, including businesses and consumers. This hearing would therefore be an opportunity for IMCO, as the Parliament's committee responsible for the Single Market, to mark this important anniversary in a public event and in dialogue with high level representatives of the Commission, the Council Presidency and main stakeholders.</p> <p>IMCO Coordinators agreed to integrate the SMEI instrument into this hearing.</p>
<b>Right to repair: Strengthening consumer rights and empowering consumers to use products longer</b> (DB, MC, SD, PS)	<p>The Commission's New Consumer Agenda and the Circular Economy Action Plan aim at promoting repair and encouraging more sustainable products. Following the call by the European Parliament to establish a right to repair for consumers, the Commission has announced to propose in the third quarter of 2022 a directive amending Directive (EU) 2019/771 (Sale of Goods Directive) and possibly a separate legislative act on the right to repair. The aim of the hearing would be to feed into the discussion related to the Commission's initiative on the right to repair and more specifically to look at how consumer rights and guarantees can be strengthened to promote repair over other remedies. The hearing could also address the role of manufacturers, traders and consumers to boost repair and reuse in the context of consumer sales, so that goods can be used for a longer time.</p>
<b>Transparency and targeting of political advertising</b> (BM/JRV/MaC)	<p>Hearing on transparency and targeting of political advertising: gathering different stakeholders to exchange views with regards to the main elements of the Commission proposal, and more in general to deepen the role of the online services providers also in view of the preparation of the next political elections (with reference to IMCO related matters); covering transparency, targeted advertising and enforcement, possibly with personalities with high media relevance such as Frances Haugen</p>

## I.5. Missions / Delegations

### I.5.1 Programme of Committee missions and ad-hoc delegations for the second half of 2022

<b>Paris, France</b>	<p>The mission to France could firstly look into issues related to sustainable consumption, lifespan of products and planned obsolescence, building up on the work done by IMCO with the INI report "A longer lifetime for products: benefits for consumers and companies (2016/2272(INI))".</p> <p>France has introduced a legal obligation that requires businesses to inform about the time period during which spare parts will be available. 'Planned obsolescence' is one of the topics where France is a pioneer, since the adoption of a legal framework on 'illegal planned obsolescence'.</p> <p>Secondly, this mission could also focus on how to boost consumer trust in products through clear and reliable consumer information and product traceability. Visits of retailers and market surveillance, customs and fraud prevention authorities could shed light on how checks and sanctions can improve transparency and consumer information, notably with regard to product components and origin.</p>
<b>Ireland / Northern Ireland</b>	<p>This mission should assess the EU-UK trading relationship and its effect on the internal market, including the application of the Northern Ireland protocol. The grace periods for the protocol has ended and there is a need to ensure the correct and full implementation of the protocol and monitor it, in addition to monitoring the ongoing trading relationship between the EU and the UK and what effects this may have on the internal market.</p>

<p><b>Israel, Tel Aviv</b></p>	<p>In the context of substantial legislative work carried out by IMCO in the area of Digital Single Market (including on DSA, DMA, IA, safety of consumer products in the light of emerging digital technologies), an ad hoc delegation to Israel would provide an opportunity for an exchange with local stakeholders, as part of evidence gathering, of an important world player in this domain. The delegation would provide an opportunity to learn more about Israel's regulatory environments boosting high-profile hubs, digital companies and technological innovation, while ensuring consumer protection, how they encourage an innovative economy and address possible unfair developments in their national markets. Additionally it would be a chance to study successful transformation of different companies from start-ups to global enterprises in recent years. This delegation could also focus on SMEs in the digital sector, as Israel is a front-runner in this area. Customs, consumer protection, standardisation and Gov-Tech – technological innovation for the public sector could also be addressed.</p>
<p><b>South Korea</b></p>	<p>For the importance of its digital and industrial model: A mission to South Korea could be of importance for the work on digital files and other internal market files. As also shown during the pandemic, Seoul is a frontrunner in e-government, use of data, research and digitalisation. But has also an important industrial dimension.</p>
