## SUGGESTIONS

The Committee on Civil Liberties, Justice and Home Affairs calls on the Committee on Budgetary Control, as the committee responsible, to incorporate the following suggestions in its motion for a resolution:

1. Is pleased to note that the Court of Auditors has been able to obtain reasonable assurances that the annual accounts of the European Union Agency for Fundamental Rights for the financial year ended 31 December 2007 are, in all material respects, reliable and that the underlying transactions, taken as a whole, are legal and regular;
2. Takes note of the comments of the Courts of Auditors about the fact that the high level of carry-overs was due to the extension of the mandate of the Agency in March 2007 and of the Agency's replies in this respect.
