## SUGGESTIONS

The Committee on Civil Liberties, Justice and Home Affairs calls on the Committee on Budgetary Control, as the committee responsible, to incorporate the following suggestions in its motion for a resolution:

1. Is pleased to note that the Court of Auditors has been able to obtain reasonable assurances that the annual accounts of the European Monitoring Centre for Drugs and Drug Addiction for the financial year ended 31 December 2008 are, in all material respects, reliable, and that the underlying transactions, taken as a whole, are legal and regular;
2. Takes note of the Court's comments as regards the fact that in order to ensure full activity-based management, allowing continuous improvement of resource allocation and performance analysis, the Centre should establish measurable objectives with relevant indicators, allocate its resources on the basis of estimated project needs and promote the achievement of results; also notes the Centre's comments in that respect;
3. Notes that in the coming years the discharge for the implementation of the budget for the Centre should be further based on the Centre's performance throughout the year.
