## SUGGESTIONS

The Committee on Civil Liberties, Justice and Home Affairs calls on the Committee on Budgetary Control, as the committee responsible, to incorporate the following suggestions in its motion for a resolution:

1. Is pleased to note that the Court of Auditors has been able to obtain reasonable assurances that the annual accounts of Frontex for the financial year 2009 are in all material respects reliable and that the underlying transactions, taken as a whole, are legal and regular;
2. Notes the amount of carry forwards and cancellations in 2009 and considers that there have been improvements due to intensive and continued monitoring of the budget combined with closer cooperation with Frontex's implementing partners in order to avoid carry forwards and cancellations;
3. Notes the current review of Frontex and its eventual implications for its budget and therefore calls on Frontex to continue improving its budgetary planning;
4. Notes that the discharge for the implementation of the budget for Frontex should be further based on its performance throughout the year.
