Justification

The European Parliament should have an active role in such an important matter, monitoring the process of issuing coins and banknotes, taking account of the high proportion of

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counterfeits and their substantial impact on the daily lives of European citizens.

Amendment 23 ARTICLE 1, POINT 3

Article 6, first paragraph (Decision 2001/923/EC)

The financial reference amount for the implementation of the Community programme of action for the period referred to in Article 1(2) last sentence shall be EUR $\boldsymbol{6}$ million.

The financial reference amount for the implementation of the Community programme of action for the period referred to in Article 1(2) last sentence shall be EUR **8.8** million.

Justification

Firstly, increasing the extension of the programme from 6 to 8 years entails an increase in the budget of 2 million euro. Secondly, the expansion of the geographical area of action of the Pericles programme to include those countries which will accede to the customs Union in the near future and the countries bordering the EU, together with the exponential increase in forged notes and coins detected in circulation between 2002 and 2004, call for an increase of at least 10% of the budget for the programme (raising it to 8.8 million euro for a period of 8 years, i.e. \in 1.1 million per year).

Amendment 24 ARTICLE 1, POINT 9

Article 13, paragraph 3, point (b) (Decision 2001/923/EC)

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Justification

An evaluation at mid-term and on completion of the programme will, on the one hand, improve scrutiny, transparency and effectiveness in the implementation and monitoring of the programme and, on the other, enable an assessment to be made at mid-term of needs, successes and failings.

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
