

If an amendment pertains to an existing act that the draft act is seeking to amend, the amendment heading includes a third line identifying the existing act and a fourth line identifying the provision in that act that Parliament wishes to amend.

Amendments by Parliament in the form of a consolidated text



DRAFT EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT LEGISLATIVE RESOLUTION

on the draft Council implementing decision on the launch of automated data exchange with regard to dactyloscopic data in Belgium (10029/2015 – C8-0196/2015 – 2015/0805(CNS))

(Special legislative procedure - consultation)

The European Parliament,

- having regard to the Council draft implementing decision on the launch of automated data exchange with regard to dactyloscopic data in Belgium (10029/2015),
- having regard to Article 39(1) of the Treaty on European Union, as amended by the Treaty of Amsterdam, and Article 9 of Protocol (No 36) on Transitional Provisions, pursuant to which the Council consulted Parliament (C8-0197/2015),
- having regard to Council Decision 2008/615/JHA of 23 June 2008 on the stepping up of cross-border cooperation, particularly in combating terrorism and cross-border crime¹, and in particular Article 33 thereof,
- having regard to its resolution of 10 October 2013 on strengthening cross-border lawenforcement cooperation in the EU: the implementation of the 'Prüm Decision' and the European Information Exchange Model²,
- having regard to its resolution of 9 July 2015 on the European Agenda on Security³,
- having regard to Rule 59 of its Rules of Procedure,
- having regard to the report of the Committee on Civil Liberties, Justice and Home Affairs (A8-0000/2015),
- 1. Approves the Council draft;
- 2. Calls on the Council to notify Parliament if it intends to depart from the text approved by Parliament;
- 3. Asks the Council to consult Parliament again if it intends to substantially amend the text approved by Parliament;
- 4. Instructs its President to forward its position to the Council, the Commission and the national parliaments.
