Subject: Opening of negotiations of an agreement with the United States of America on

strengthening international supply chains of critical minerals

On 14 June 2023, the Commission proposed a recommendation for a Council decision authorising the opening of negotiations of an agreement with the United States of America on strengthening international supply chains of critical minerals (CMA).

- 1. According to the Commission's assessment, which EU sectors will benefit the most from the agreement?
- 2. How will the Commission ensure that the agreement will be compatible with World Trade Organization rules?
- 3. To what extent will the agreement cover recycled minerals, in line with the objectives of the Critical Raw Materials Act, to promote recycling capacity in the European Union?
- 4. Will the Commission aim to have all 50 minerals covered in the US Inflation Reduction Act included in the agreement?
- 5. How would such an agreement provide an impetus to establish a critical raw materials club, mitigate risks for supply chains, reduce unwanted strategic dependencies and promote cooperation on critical raw materials with reliable partners, in line with open strategic autonomy?
