Subject: European register of fingerprints of asylum-seekers (Eurodac)

In view of the Danish reservation on judicial cooperation (Edinburgh agreement), will the Commission state whether or not Denmark may participate in Eurodac, the common fingerprint register?

What conditions does Denmark have to meet if it is to participate in Eurodac on an equal footing with the other countries taking part?

Can the Commission confirm that Denmark may participate in Eurodac only if it fully accepts the jurisdiction of the Court of Justice?
