Subject: Temelin nuclear power plant environmental impact assessment

In light of the report on the above assessment, preparation of which was agreed in Melk in December 2000 and concluded with a public hearing in Vienna in June 2001, does the Commission agree that the Czech Republic has fulfilled the commitments made at Melk? Does the Commission also agree that there are no safety reasons why the commissioning of number one reactor should not proceed?
