Subject: Parliamentary scrutiny of ACP CSPs

The Commission is aware of the decision to give the JPA the right to scrutinise ACP CSPs. Is the Commission aware, however, that the CSPs were distributed to the speakers of individual parliaments and to the JPA parliamentarians of those countries?

In the interests of ensuring that the process of parliamentary oversight is being satisfactorily managed, would the Commission request that EU delegations in ACP countries provide information on whether there were plenary debates, discussions in standing or select committees or any other form of consultation process on CSPs in the countries for which they are responsible?
