## Question for written answer P-004761/2013/rev.1 to the Commission Rule 117 Emine Bozkurt (S&D)

Subject: Pelješac bridge

Can the Commission confirm that it has agreed with the Croatian Government to draw up a strategy to improve connections with Croatia's southern territory (the Dubrovnik region)?

If this is indeed the case, will the Commission answer the following questions:

- 1. When is the strategy expected to be finalised?
- 2. What are the proposed solutions?
- 3. Will EU funding be used for these purposes?
- 4. Is one of the solutions the construction of the Pelješac bridge?
- 5. In the event that the bridge is to be built, will it be financed or co-financed by the EU?

The future bridge between Croatia's mainland and its Pelješac peninsula would bypass a stretch of the coast at Neum, where Bosnia and Herzegovina has access to the Adriatic Sea.

- 6. Neighbouring Bosnia and Herzegovina claims that the bridge would limit its access to the sea and territorial waters. How is the Commission dealing with these concerns?
- 7. To what extent does the Commission consider open bilateral border disputes to be a potential obstacle to Bosnia and Herzegovina's accession process?
