Subject: What is considered a crime in the EU with regard to 'Islamic State'?

- 1. I would like to ask you for an explanation, in facts and figures, of the precise legal status of people who leave Europe to fight for 'Islamic State' and then return.
- 2. Does this in itself constitute a criminal act, or are they held responsible for a criminal act only if they actually commit a terrorist act in the EU on their return?
- 3. If it is not currently a crime, should the fact of somebody fighting abroad for a terrorist organisation not be declared a crime sui generis (one of a kind)? If such a person returned to Europe, they might face prosecution; if they were not a European citizen, they could be expelled.
