Subject: Application of artificial intelligence to the European labour market

The Commission communication of 25 April 2018 on Artificial Intelligence for Europe outlined how the EU is preparing to adopt artificial intelligence (AI) and integrate it into the future economy, with one of the subjects mentioned being the impact of AI on the labour market transition. The EU intends to tackle the labour market transition by, among other things, providing support via the European Structural and Investment Funds and through plans such as the New Skills Agenda for Europe.

1. What does the Commission intend to do at EU level to help increase efforts in support of those members of the labour pool who will become unemployed as a result of AI?
2. How will the Commission ensure that these workers are able to make a smooth transition back into the modernised workforce on a social level?
