Subject: Târgu Mureş-Iaşi-Ungheni motorway

The North-East region of Romania is one of the least developed regions in the EU. The lack of adequate infrastructure and interconnections with other regions is one of the reasons for this situation. This is why the construction of the Târgu Mureş-Iaşi-Ungheni motorway is an imperative which could significantly contribute to the development of the region.

The proposed motorway is part of the TEN-T core network, and thus could be financed through EU structural funds. Unfortunately, no concrete steps have been taken at national level to implement this important project.

Taking into account the commitments made by Romania and the EU's objective of having the TEN-T core network in place by 2030, how could Romania be affected by non-compliance with these obligations?

What are the measures that the Commission can implement in order to ensure that the national authorities will take the necessary actions in this regard?
