Subject: Protecting sugar producers in EU countries

Sugar prices are no longer regulated in the European Union, and the EU's internal market has been opened up to sugar from countries in which it is subsidised. With that in mind, and after consulting sugar producers, organisations of workers, farmers and raw materials suppliers in the sugar industry, I should like to ask the Commission whether, and if so when, it will introduce an internal market defence mechanism to protect EU producers against unfair trade practices on the part of the EU's partners in third countries?
