Subject: Clean Air Programme

The Clean Air Programme is being implemented in Poland with the support of EU funding to finance insulation for homes and the installation of more environmentally-friendly stoves. The programme is worth EUR 35 billion and will involve replacing 4 million coal-fired stoves and building insulation over 10 years. On 1 July the Commission decided to discontinue providing EU assistance to the programme as the Polish authorities had failed to introduce the necessary reforms.

I would like to ask the following:

- 1. What were the Commission's recommendations for the reform of the programme which the Polish authorities failed to carry out?
- 2. What action must the Polish Government take for the Commission to decide to continue its participation in the Clean Air Programme?
- 3. Does the Commission see a threat to the conclusion of its cooperation with Poland in the context of the Clean Air Programme?
