Subject: VP/HR - Turkey's military offensive in north-eastern Syria

Turkey has launched a military offensive in the north-east of Syria, which, according to the EU, will further undermine stability throughout the region. This unilateral action is forcing people from their homes and a number of civilians have already been killed.

The so-called 'safe zone' that Turkey is keen to establish could give rise to serious breaches of international law if refugees – to whom the EU is providing financial support – are sent back against their will.

In the light of the foregoing:

- 1. Will the VP/HR be suggesting an EU-level arms embargo that goes beyond the one agreed to in the Council Conclusions of 14 October 2019?
- 2. Will the EEAS be carrying out any monitoring to ensure that Member States comply with common position 2008/944/CFSP?
