**Subject:** Financial support from the EU and its Member States for developing countries aimed at reducing greenhouse gas emissions

According to a press release issued by the Council of the European Union on 8 November 2019, the EU and its Member States allocated EUR 21.7 billion to developing countries in 2018 alone to reduce greenhouse gas emissions <sup>1</sup>. The figure for the previous year was EUR 20.4 billion. There is, however, no mention of who the donors and the receivers of this funding are. Nor is there any indication of how the proper use of the funds is evaluated or what the outcome of this has been.

1. Who are the donors and the recipients of the EUR 21.7 billion for reducing greenhouse gas emissions in developing countries?
2. For which projects and measures has this amount been used / is this amount being used?
3. What were the results of any evaluations which may have been conducted of the use of the EUR 21.7 billion?
