Subject: Commission position on new coronavirus

According to the World Health Organisation (WHO), on 31 December 2019, a cluster of pneumonia cases of unknown origin was detected in Wuhan, Hubei Province, China. On 7 January, the Chinese authorities identified a new type of coronavirus — different from any other previously known human coronavirus — as the cause of this viral pneumonia.

Up to 198 cases had been identified by that time, including 4 cases imported into Thailand (2), Japan (1) and South Korea (1).

In light of this:

- 1. What action does the European Commission intend to take to control and prevent the spread of the coronavirus on European territory?
- 2. What measures does the European Commission intend to adopt to ensure the rapid detection of this virus in the various Member States?
- 3. In order to ensure that the virus is not spread through imports, how will the European Commission ensure effective monitoring of imported goods?
