Between 20 and 26 countries are participating in the four joint procurement procedures on personal protective equipment, ventilators and laboratory equipment, under the joint procurement agreement of medical countermeasures (JPA)<sup>1</sup> depending on the tender concerned. Member States can order the equipment now.

The Commission gathers the needs of Member States and manages the procurement process according to the EU financial rules<sup>2</sup> and the JPA. The aim is to improve economies of scale and support equitable access to the market.

Information related to procurement procedures is confidential until the contracts are signed. Once signed, the information about the participating countries will be published in the supplement to the Official Journal<sup>3</sup>.

Quantities and delivery schedules depend on the market response to the procurement process.

The exact delivery schedules and distribution depend on the timing of the individual orders placed by the participating countries.

Under the JPA, the Member States share their needs and orders in confidence and the Commission will not communicate breakdowns by country without prior authorisation.
