## Priority question for written answer P-004818/2020 to the Commission

Subject: Scope of local self-government regarding the base stations of public mobile networks

Article 57 of Directive (EU) 2018/1972 <sup>1</sup> stipulates that competent authorities shall not unduly restrict the deployment of small-area wireless access points.

The Croatian Regulatory Authority for Network Industries (HAKOM) claims that this provision refers to 5G base stations of public mobile networks and negates Article 4 (the scope of local self-government) of the European Charter of Local Self-Government <sup>2</sup>.

Does Article 57 of Directive (EU) 2018/1972 refer solely to short-reach wireless technology, or can it also refer to the base stations of public mobile networks?
