On 22 October 2019, the Commission published the 2019 Cooperation and Verification Mechanism (CVM) report on Romania. The report has two parts: one political and one technical. As proven by journalists¹ and legal practitioners from Romania, both of these documents contain many factual errors, inaccuracies, and 'recommendations' that go against the Romanian Constitution. I would therefore like to ask the Commission to provide detailed answers to the following questions:

- 1. Who wrote the 2019 CVM report on Romania and what is their educational background?
- 2. Who is taking responsibility for the factual errors, inaccuracies and 'recommendations' included in the 2019 CVM report that go against the decisions of the Romanian Constitutional Court?
- 3. What is the Commission doing to correct the errors in the 2019 report and to prevent any future errors in the upcoming CVM reports on Romania?
