Subject: Commission support for the extradition of the murderers of Niccolò Ciatti

Acting on a European arrest warrant, the French police recently arrested a Chechen citizen in Strasbourg for beating Niccolò Ciatti, a young Italian, to death in a nightclub in Lloret de Mar (Spain) on 12 August 2017.

Movsar Magomedov, a 24-year-old residing in Strasbourg where he had requested political asylum, is one of three Chechen men who brutally murdered Niccolò in the summer of 2017. The other two are 26-year-old Rassoul Bissultanov, who has been awaiting trial in a Spanish prison for the past three and a half years, and Khabibul Kabatov, who has disappeared without a trace.

In view of the above, can the Commission say:

- 1. What can be done to ensure those behind this brutal murder are handed over to Italian justice?
- 2. How can the French authorities be persuaded to verify the real legal situation of the third aggressor, who remains at large?
