Subject: Hungary's new anti-LGBTQIA+ law

The recent adoption of the controversial anti-LGBTQIA+ law proposed by Hungarian Prime Minister Viktor Orbán and his Fidesz party is an infringement of human rights and the rights of the members of that community in Europe. This absurd piece of legislation prohibits the 'promotion of homosexuality' wherever it might be observed by juveniles. Such a state of affairs must not simply be allowed to stand, especially in a Member State that is duty-bound to comply with the EU Treaties and respect our European values.
