Subject: Whole of SS 106 road not included in proposal for TEN-T network

On 14 December 2021 the Commission published its proposal for the revision of the TEN-T Regulation, concerning which the undersigned had tabled a question for written answer on 1 September 2021 asking whether would be possible to include the whole of the SS 106 road in the TEN-T project on the grounds that this road is key to the development of southern Italy.

In its answer on 12 November 2021 the Commission said it would be willing to assess such a proposal should the Italian authorities suggest it.

However, there are no changes along these lines in the Commission's revised TEN-T proposal, which leaves a large part of the SS 106 (from Catanzaro to Reggio Calabria) out of the comprehensive network.

Can the Commission confirm whether this happened because the Italian authorities did not request these changes or because the EU authorities rejected their request, in which case, on what grounds was it rejected?
