Subject: Follow-up parliamentary question: letter of formal notice regarding transposition by the

Member States of Directive (EU) 2018/957 amending the directive on the posting of

workers

On 9 July 2018, Directive (EU) 2018/957 amending Directive 96/71/EC concerning the posting of workers in the framework of the provision of services was published in the Official Journal, requiring Member States to transpose the provisions thereof into national law by 30 July 2020 at the latest.

In reply to a question from Parliament (P-005376/2020), the Commission indicated that letters of formal notice had been sent to 14 Member States and to the United Kingdom on 8 October 2020, asking them to inform it within two months of the measures taken to transpose each of the provisions of the Directive. Subsequently, on 1 February 2021 (P-006800/2020), the Commission indicated that nine Member States and the United Kingdom had notified their national measures transposing the Directive.

- 1. Which Member States have still not transposed Directive (EU) 2018/957 on 1 January 2022?
- 2. What steps will the European Commission take to urge those Member States to do so as soon as possible?
