- 1. Does the Commission agree that by censoring information on the president's relationship and communications with Pfizer, our right to information and transparency has been seriously infringed?

Can and will the Commission disclose all information including but not limited to electronic internal and external correspondence (e.g. emails and WhatsApp messages), statistics, reports, minutes, notes and information on gifts and (pre)contractual agreements related to entities and individuals (e.g. the World Economic Forum, Klaus Schwab, the Bilderberg Group, Bill Gates, George Soros, Ab Osterhaus and healthcare and pharmaceutical companies) that have advocated, in any form whatsoever, COVID-19 vaccines, tests, protective equipment, certificates and other restrictions and restrictive measures prior to and following the outbreak of this 'pandemic'?

Can and will the Commission disclose all information including but not limited to electronic internal and external correspondence (e.g. emails and WhatsApp messages), statistics, reports, minutes and notes related to the ineffectiveness and side effects of and deaths and socio-economic consequences associated with COVID-19 vaccines, tests, protective equipment (e.g. face masks), certificates, restrictions and restrictive measures, whatever the data's form and irrespective whether it has been proven?
