Subject: Supply chain disruption due to war in Ukraine

The war in Ukraine, besides causing unimaginable suffering to millions of people, is also creating a huge economic crisis. Ukraine is one of Europe's largest producers of cereals, minerals, metals and chemical fertilisers. Many European companies have suffered because the supply of raw materials and production components sourced from war zones has been limited or completely blocked.

We would therefore like to ask whether the Commission is already drawing up a plan to mitigate these negative consequences, to help reorganise supply chains, and to support companies experiencing disruptions in their production chains?
