Subject: Transposition of the Work-Life Balance Directive

The Work-Life Balance Directive¹ was adopted in 2019. The aim of the Directive is to achieve a better balance between family and work obligations.

Member States were required to transpose the directive into national law by 2 August 2022 at the latest.

- 1. Can the Commission say which Member States had transposed the directive by 2 August 2022?
- 2. Will Member States that have failed to meet the deadline be penalised?
- 3. What measures can the Commission take in the event of non-transposition?
