Subject: Conditions for liability of the Member States with regard to COVID-19 vaccines

In response to question E-001396/2022¹ on liability for COVID-19 vaccines, part of the Commission's reply was as follows: 'Although those agreements typically provide for Member States to indemnify the manufacturer for possible liabilities incurred under specific conditions set out in the agreement, in accordance with the directive, liability remains with the company.'²
