Subject: Lesbian human rights defenders sentenced to death in Iran

The Urmia Revolutionary Court has sentenced two lesbian human rights defenders (HRDs) – Zahra Sediqi Hamedani ('Sareh') and Elham Chubdar– to death on charges of 'corruption on earth through the promotion of homosexuality'. A third activist – Soheila Ashrafi – is also being held in the Urmia Central Prison together with Sareh and Elham awaiting a verdict on similar charges¹.

These are harrowing developments that call for an EU response, not least because the EU has adopted guidelines on the death penalty², LGBTI persons' human rights³, EU policy towards third countries on torture⁴ and on HRDs⁵.

- 1. The EU does not have a delegation in Iran, yet its position is represented by the Member State holding the Council Presidency⁶. What actions is the EEAS taking, in coordination with the Czech Embassy and/or other EU embassies in Tehran, to advocate against the imposition of the death penalty in the aforementioned cases? Has there been any contact with the HRDs?
- 2. Will the EEAS coordinate with the UN Special Rapporteurs on Iran,⁷ on HRDs⁸, on torture⁹ and the Independent Expert on SOGI¹⁰ in order to have a joint international call on not imposing the death penalty?
- 3. How are the above-mentioned EU guidelines being implemented, is COHOM aware of the current cases and will a recommendation be made to the Political and Security Council?
