Subject: Can an approval by JASPERS and by the Commission on waste management projects

be withdrawn?

In order for a project such as a waste management centre (WMC) in a Member State to be funded and to come into service, it must be approved/verified by both JASPERS (the Joint Assistance to Support Projects in European Regions initiative) and then the competent body of the European Commission, in this case its Directorate-General for Regional and Urban Policy.

- 1. Can approval be withdrawn once it has been given on a certain project (for example, a WMC)?
- 2. For what reasons can such a withdrawal be made?
- 3. Is there a time limit within which an approval may be withdrawn?
