Subject: When will an end be put to the actions of the climate anarchists of the self-proclaimed

'Last Generation'?

Under the pretext of a noble cause – in this case climate protection – the self-proclaimed 'Last Generation' group has carried out a large number of offences and criminal acts as part of its so-called climate activism, including damage to property¹, arson², dangerous interference with traffic, obstruction of emergency services³ and interference with aviation⁴. For example, representatives of 'last generation' glued themselves onto runways at several airports.

This not only hinders air traffic and causes significant economic damage to passenger and freight transport, but also calls into question the security concept and thus the authorisation of airports, since only authorised persons may enter the airfield after appropriate checks.

- 1. What is the Commission's view on the designation of this organisation as a terrorist organisation?
- 2. When could the organisation's funds be frozen?
- 3. When could the organisation's funders be sanctioned?
