Subject: Photographer, hairdresser and make-up artist costs for the Commission – part 2

The Commission stated that it had spent EUR 2 756 286 on photographers and make-up artists during the current legislative period (end of 2019 to end of April 2023), 95% of which on photographers and videographers<sup>1</sup>. Some EUR 140 000 was spent on make-up artists.

- 1. What is the breakdown of those costs by payment recipient?
- 2. Who are the make-up artists concerned, what services do they provide (only make-up work or also hairdressing?) and on what occasions and by which Commissioners have make-up artists been used?
- 3. Why cannot costs be broken down by individual Commissioners, and is it planned in the interests of transparency to make that possible in the future?
