Subject: Implementation and enforcement of the mobility package

The mobility package has been in force for some time already: the rules on driving time and rest conditions have been in force since August 2020, and Member States had until February 2022 to transpose the directive on posting drivers in the road transport sector. However, we have seen little in the way of improvement of working conditions in the sector thus far. It would appear that Member States are carrying out only limited checks on the implementation of and compliance with the rules on posting, on driving and on rest periods. Moreover, these limited checks show that the rules are being flouted on a regular basis. A consistent and harmonised application of the rules is lacking.

1. Does the 2021-2022 biennial report on the impact of the mobility package confirm the finding that enforcement by Member States through controls and fines leaves much to be desired?
2. What additional steps will the Commission take to ensure that Member States consistently fulfil their enforcement obligations?
3. Does the Commission intend to declare Member States who fail to comply with their enforcement obligations or do so inadequately to be in infringement of their duties?
