Subject: Implementation of Directive 2003/88/EC in Denmark

Following the ruling of the Court of Justice of the European Union (CJEU) of 14 May 2019 in Case C-55/18, the implementation of Directive 2003/88/EC in Denmark is now being modified to comply with this and a number of other CJEU rulings.

The proposed new rules for recording working time in line with the CJEU's interpretation of the Directive might constitute a significant change to the way the Directive has been implemented in Denmark thus far.

In the light of this:

In the Commission's opinion, would it be in accordance with the Directive to introduce a risk-based approach whereby the requirements for recording daily working time apply only to those workplaces where there is reasonable doubt regarding adherence to the rules?
