Subject: Monitoring the safety, health effects and excess mortality of vaccines

Following up on the Commission's reply to a question¹ on the number of citizens inoculated against COVID-19 using vaccine doses, I request clarifications on some points.

The International Coalition of Medicines Regulatory Authorities (ICMRA) is not a relevant source for information on COVID-19 vaccine safety, health effects or excess mortality. I therefore request additional answers and data.

1. What exact scientific data, scientific report(s) or scientific publication(s) were the basis for the Commission's answer that 'no safety signal for increased mortality with any of the authorised COVID-19 vaccines has been identified by EMA to date'?
2. What exact scientific data, scientific report(s) or scientific publication(s) are the basis for the assertion made in the Commission's answer that 'in fact, COVID-19 vaccines have saved millions of lives'?
